

Check-In FAQs

How long will it take me to get through Check-In?

Once you reach the Registration table (Table #1), it should take you 30 to 45 minutes.

What are the times of Check-In?

Check-In is scheduled from 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. You will be assigned a check-in time by Admissions.

If you are arriving early for athletics training camps, band or cheerleading, your coach will provide information about when to report and what you need to have completed in order to begin your program. Athletes must still complete the Check-In process on Thursday, August 20 and will report to Stokes at an assigned time along with your teammates. The schedule is as follows:

When do international students check in? International students will check-in at 1:30 p.m.

When do commuters check in? Commuters are scheduled to check in from 2 p.m. until 3:30 p.m.

When can I move into my room?

Once you have completed the check-in process, you can go to your residence hall. RAs will be available to answer any housing questions and give you your room key.

Do we have to stop at every table? We advise you to stop at all tables. Tables #2 through #23 are required stops.

Where can we get lunch?

Lunch is available in Torvian Dining Hall from 10:30 a.m. – 1:45 p.m. Frankie's in the JFK Center is open from 8 a.m. until 7 p.m. The Cart in Padua Hall is open 7:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m. Adamucci's in Schwab Hall will open on Sunday, August 28.
